

# **Note from our Pro**

I put a call into the SCGA Course Rating department regarding the temporary tees and green we will be using during the construction of the pond on #13, and the following is how Doug Sullivan responded:

If you use Net Pars on those two holes for handicap purposes, there's no need to adjust the ratings etc. Golfers simply play those two holes from whatever tees are in play and for competition purposes the score they make is their competition score. However, for handicap purposes they simply post net pars (similar to a hole not played) for handicap purposes based on the course's normal layout.

I hope this will help during this short construction window.
