

TEMPORARY RELIEF FOR HOLE #13 POND

Hole #13 Pond is temporarily considered a **No Play Zone in Abnormal Course Condition**

The player <u>must</u> take relief under Rule 16.1b:

If a players ball is in the general area and there is interference by an abnormal course condition on the course, the player <u>must</u> take free relief by dropping <u>another ball</u> in this relief area:

<u>Reference Point</u>: The nearest point of complete relief in the general area. <u>Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point</u>: One club-length, but with these limits: must be in the general area, must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and there must be complete relief from all interference by the abnormal ground condition.

If the player is unable to find a reference point that is not nearer the hole, the player may drop another ball in the nearest designated drop zone.

Note: If your ball goes into pond it is a free drop as described above, no penalty. (YOU MAY NOT ENTER THAT AREA TO RETRIEVE YOUR BALL FOR ANY REASON.)

If you are inside the white lines around the pond, that is considered ground under repair and you may also take relief as described above.







