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Subject: Resident Access Changes

Canyon Lake, CA – Resident access changes are coming in 2020. Beginning in January, the Canyon Lake POA will be transitioning away from annual vehicle decals for resident access. The North Gate will be the first gate to transition on January 13, after this date residents will need to have an RFID transponder to use the Resident Lane, otherwise they will need to use the Guest Lane. The East Gate will follow on February 17, after this date the RFID/Oversized Only Lane will remain and the current Decal Lane will be converted into an RFID, POA Card, and Returning Guest (with pass) Lane. Residents without an RFID transponder or POA card will need to use the guest lane. Lastly, the Main Gate will transition on March 16 with the same lane structure as the East Gate.

Some members already have a 2020 windshield decal on their vehicle. Effective on the transition dates, that decal will no longer provide access, however it will continue to serve as a parking decal through its expiration month. Upon expiration, or anytime before, residents may visit the Canyon Lake POA office to receive a new permanent parking decal.

RFID is an acronym for Radio Frequency Identification Device. The RFID transponder is a physical tag applied to the vehicle or golf cart which triggers the gate to open. RFID access is a faster and more efficient way to enter the community. The Canyon Lake POA introduced RFIDs to the community in 2015, and since that time 80% of community has obtained an RFID transponder. There are currently RFID only lanes at both East Gate and Main Gate, and those lanes operate much more efficiently than the decal lanes.

RFID transponders are free for Canyon Lake POA members, simply visit the Canyon Lake POA office with the vehicle or golf cart that needs an RFID transponder and our friendly staff will apply the transponder.
