

Senior Center Work Group

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1 of the Bylaws of the Canyon Lake Property Owners Association grants the Board of Directors the power to conduct, manage and control the affairs and business of the Association; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 2(l) of the Bylaws grants the Board of Directors the power to appoint such committees as may be necessary to, or convenient in, the discharge of any of its obligations or powers; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section I(e) of the Bylaws grants the Board of Directors the power to appoint committees of the Association:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Canyon Lake Senior Center Work Group be established having the following terms of reference:

RESPONSIBILITY

The primary responsibility of the Canyon Lake Senior Center Work Group is to advise the Board of Directors, hereinafter referred to as the Board, on new programs and concepts for use at the Canyon Lake Senior Center. The Work Group will recommend action that should be addressed by the Board through the General Manager.

In fulfilling its responsibility, the Canyon Lake Senior Center Work Group, in cooperation with the General Manager, shall:

- Review and make recommendations to the Board on Programs and Social Events; and
- Review and make recommendations in cooperation with the General Manager or designee as it relates to the regularly scheduled activities; and
- Submit recommendations through the Activities Department for request of additional use of the facility (i.e. new scheduled events, weekly activities, etc.).
- The Work Group shall also perform such other related functions as directed by the Board of Directors.
- Assist with the various groups in use of the Senior Center.

MEMBERSHIP

The Senior Center Work Group shall be composed of nine (9) members. The members shall be appointed by the Board. The membership of the Work Group should be representative of the membership in Canyon Lake.

The General Manager or designee will be non-voting, ex-officio members of this Committee.
