Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2

Value A: $24.3 + 12 = 36.3$ | Value B: $16.2 + 12 = 28.2$

A / B: $36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128$

Improvement factor: 1.128

Please Park on the Path

Fight the urge to pull off the path when parking near tees and greens. The maintenance team and your fellow golfers will thank you for it.

We've probably all done it – driven our golf cart up to a green or tee, pulled to the side of the path and parked with a couple of tires on the grass. It's a natural impulse. When you stop driving almost any other vehicle you pull over for safety and try to keep the roadway clear. On the golf course, you want other golfers or maintenance vehicles to get by. Unfortunately, our tendency to pull over onto the grass creates bad lies and a bunch of repair work for the maintenance team. It's counterintuitive, but we should actually park with all four tires on the path, even if it seems like we're blocking the way. Otherwise, some familiar problems are sure to develop.

In areas where a lot of carts park, it doesn't take many people pulling over onto the grass to cause damage. What starts as a small bare spot will keep growing with more traffic. The bigger the bare patch gets, the more it looks like a great place to park and the worse it becomes. The soil gets compacted and settles, and the area may hold water after rain or irrigation – creating a puddle for carts to splash through as they pull over. The maintenance team can fix these damaged areas, but that takes up a lot of time they don't have to spare.

Bare spots along paths are more than just a problem for the maintenance team, they also create bad lies that can make a mess of your scorecard. It's no fun trying to hit a delicate chip onto the green from a bare dirt lie near a cart path. The Rules of Golf only allow for relief from these areas if they're marked or otherwise defined as ground under repair, or the path directly interferes with your stance or swing. That means there's a decent chance you're playing from the dirt if you're unlucky enough to end up there.

Parking with all four tires on the path, especially near tees and greens, is the only way to prevent this issue. Fight the urge to pull onto the grass! Chances are, nobody will need to go around you while you're parked on the path. If someone does, it's better that they pass once on the grass instead of you parking there every single time. Adding curbs or widening paths can help prevent damage, but those adjustments cost money and they don't always solve the parking problem. Changing our behavior is definitely the best fix.



In Memoriam ~ Gene Brown

July 29, 1926 – February 20, 2024

Gene Brown, 97 years old, was an original member of the Canyon Lake Men's Golf Club, founded in October 1971. He was also the seventh President of the Men's Golf Club, serving as president in 1977. Gene and his wife Clara bought their lot in Canyon Lake in 1969, one year after the Corona Land Company saw the potential for development in Canyon Lake and started selling lots in 1968. Gene and Clara lived in Long Beach, CA most of his business career where he owned a material damage appraisal company. They built their home on Sea Horse Circle during the '70's and Gene would often strap his golf bag to his motorcycle and head to Canyon Lake for a round or two of golf. They moved to Canyon Lake full time in the 1980's.

Gene was honored by the Canyon Lake Men's Golf Club with a "**Lifetime Membership**" in March 2021 at the Spring Kick-off Golf Tournament during the opening ceremony of the 50th Anniversary of the Men's Golf Club. Gene and fellow Lifetime Member, Jim Lippen hit "opening tee shots" to kick-off the year long celebration of the Club's 50th Anniversary.

Gene liked to share his early memories of Canyon Lake Country Club and its development through the years. He shared that "the golf course was always planned to be an 18-hole course, but first opened as a nine-hole course with the back nine as we know it today". The original first hole was #12 as we know it today and the 18th hole was today's #11. (You figure out the rest of the hole rotations). When the course grew into an 18-hole layout, there was a pond on #6 where the bunker on the right is, and on hole #16 there was a pond at the bottom of the hill where today's two bunkers are located. He also recalled that during the 9-hole days, the members would collect rocks from the fairways and rough and deposit them in two piles on then hole #16 creating what we now call "Dolly". As a Past President, Gene remained a member of the Canyon Lake Association of Past Presidents (CLAPPS) until his passing. Clara passed away several years ago. Gene will be long be remembered for his contributions to the development of the golf course and will be truly missed by those who had the opportunity to know him throughout the years. Rest in Peace good and faithful friend!
